PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Plan Commission of the Town of Polk will hold a Public Hearing on Wednesday, October 7, 2020 at 7:00 p.m., at the Polk Town Hall, 3680 State Hwy 60, Slinger to consider:

PETITION by the Town Board of the Town of Polk to amend the Town of Polk Zoning Map by the reversal of zoning of those lands located within the Town of Polk as described below:

Said parcels are described in part as:

Located that part of PT OF SW-NE, Sect. 12, T10N, R19E, Town of Polk, Washington County.

Said lands containing 80 acres, more or less. Parcels T9-0470, 047000A, 0471, 0472, 047200A.

The Petition to amend the map is made to return the subject parcels of land to their original zoning of A-1 General Agricultural District from their current basic zoning districts of B-1 Business District and R-2 Multifamily Residential District; and from the PUD Planned Unit Development Overlay District.

During the Public Hearing, the public is invited to speak on the proposed rezoning. The Public Hearing shall be closed when all interested parties in attendance have had an opportunity to offer comment. Comments may be received in writing until 5:00pm the date of the hearing.

Upon the close of the Public Hearing, a meeting of the Town Plan Commission shall be called to order, and the Petition shall be addressed per the agenda.
